Course 600: Environmental Awareness

Course Description:

This one-day course introduces basic principles of ecology, history of the environmental movement, a review of federal/state/local environmental legislation, the right of way professional's role in the environmental process, and mitigation of environmental impacts. Participants will become familiar with environmental issues and problems facing companies and agencies acquiring or managing real property and rights of way, will learn various environmental issues and the mitigating measures used to decrease environmental impacts, and will gain increased awareness of environmental laws, regulations and associated regulatory agencies.

Topics:

- Background on environmental movement, environmental history, environmental disasters that lead to litigation and/or regulations, environmental legislation
- Environmental documents, environmental impact statement, environmental assessment, findings of no significant impact, categorical exclusion, record of decision
- Factors ensuring environmental compliance with the National Environmental Policy Act, state and local regulations; air, water and land regulations; land use control
- Right of way agent's definitive role in the environmental process, developing environmental "eyes"
- Defining environmental awareness, being part of an environmental process, scoping environmental documents and project planning
