Eligibility:

The International Right of Way Association welcomes applicants to apply for a Right of Way Scholarship. Applicants must be a member in good standing for one year and be committed to achieving either the RWA or RWP credential. Scholarship funding may only be used towards the course registration fees for eligible courses. Courses must be completed within three years from the award date.

Schedule:

Applications may be submitted from the IRWA website beginning July 10, 2017. The deadline for application is September 30, 2017. Grantees will be notified by December 1, 2017 and the award will begin on January 1, 2018.

Distribution:

Region Vice Chairs will recommend 2 qualified recipients from their respective regions. The balance of the scholarship recipients will be selected without regard to geographical location by a committee of no more than 5 Region Vice Chairs.
